7 O'clock Drunk Drivers

Santa Fe—State Police officers arrested two drunk drivers this week, each just before 7 p.m.

On Saturday July 7th just before 7 p.m. State Police officer Penny Ryan was driving south on I-25 near milepost 279 when she noticed a semi-truck swerving. She watched and followed the truck for about two miles before pulling over the Yellow Company tractor trailer. The driver, Daniel Perez Magdaleno (2/16/1963) of Santa Ana, CA was unsteady on his feet as he climbed out of the truck. Officer Ryan also noticed the front of his pants were wet. She attempted to administer field sobriety tests but Magdaleno was unable to successfully complete them. He was arrested and consented to a breath test which indicated a BAC of .22.

Magdaleno was charged with aggravated DWI and booked in to the Santa Fe County Detention Center.

On Sunday also just before 7 p.m. a drunk driver backed into State Police Sergeant Ted Carr in Pecos. Sgt. Carr was stopped at an intersection when he saw a blue Neon nearly collide with other vehicles in the intersection. As he attempted to stop the car, the driver put the Neon into reverse and hit the police car.

Arsenio R. Anaya (7/15/64) of Las Vegas, NM was unable to perform the field sobriety test administered by State Police. He was asked to submit to a breath

test but refused. A search warrant to collect blood for a test was executed. Results are still pending.

Anaya was arrested for the 7th time on DWI charges. He was also charged with felony DWI, driving with a suspended or revoked license, open container and careless driving. He was booked into the San Miguel County Detention Center.
