Afternoon Ride Turns Fatal

Madrid – Glenn Soesbe, 6/18/1942, of Tijeras was fatally injured when the motorcycle he was operating crashed into a guardrail.

Yesterday afternoon State Police officers were alerted to a single vehicle crash three miles south of the town of Madrid. The crash occurred just after noon on the northbound lanes of State Road 14, near mile marker 24. The officers' investigation has revealed that Glenn Soesbe, 6/18/1942, was operating his 2008 Harley Davidson motorcycle when he lost control and drove into a guardrail. Glenn and his wife were thrown from the motorcycle; Jean Soesbe was transported to Christus St. Vincent's Hospital, and was listed in stable condition as of this morning.

Glenn Soesbe was pronounced deceased by the Office of the Medical Investigator. Helmets were used by both operator and passenger. Alcohol was not a contributing factor in the crash.
