One Dies in Motorcycle Crash

Roswell—Luann Woodruff died in a motorcycle crash 20 miles northwest of Roswell on SR 246 Sunday afternoon.

Evidence at the scene indicates that the motorcycle she was driving left the road at a slow speed and then tipped over. It is unclear if the crash was the primary cause of death. She was pronounced dead at the scene by a deputy medical investigator from the Office of the Medical Investigator.

The State Police was notified of the crash at about 3:30 Sunday afternoon. Luann Woodruff (12/13/56) of Roswell was driving a 2009 Kawasaki when she left the roadway.

The exact cause and manner of death is still under investigation. She was not wearing a helmet or protective riding gear at the time of the crash. Alcohol has also been ruled out as a contributing factor.
