**CERTIFICATION BY WAIVER OF PREVIOUS TRAINING
REQUIRED EQUIPMENT**

1. 3" 3 ring binder, notebook paper, pens, and #2 pencils. Highlighter pens are recommended.
2. The service weapon used on duty.

The Training Center will provide 9mm, .45acp, .40 S&W, and .357 Sig ammunition for semi-automatics. At least three (3) magazines are required, four (4) if carrying a .45 cal.

For revolvers, the use of speed loaders is highly recommended. A combination of two speed loaders and six round shell loop is ideal. Alternatively, shell loops alone are required as a minimum. "Dump" pouches are not acceptable.

If any other caliber is used, the student must bring 500 rounds of duty or duty EQUIVALENT ammunition. Full wadcutter ammunition is not acceptable.

All weapons will be inspected for safe operation while at the Training Center. Modifications to inherent safeties are not acceptable (i.e., magazine disconnect, grip safety and rebound slide springs must not be altered).

3. Ear and eye protection.

"Wrap around" eye protection (clear for night fire) and "ear muff" type hearing protection is highly recommended.

4. Complete gun cleaning kit.
5. Flashlight with spare batteries and bulb.

The Flashlight must have a pressure switch allowing for instant on/off capability.

6. A serviceable pair of handcuffs (chain only, no hinged) and at least one (1) key.
7. Business Casual wear for classroom, i.e Docker type slacks, knit shirts with collars such as Polo shirts (t-shirts, shorts, and other recreation clothing is not allowed).
8. Appropriate clothing for Defensive Tactics and Physical Agility assessment, training, and testing. Gray gym shorts, t-shirts and warm-up suits recommended (No metal zippers allowed during D.T.) White socks should be worn when in gym gear. A pair of **high quality running shoes** is recommended for physical fitness assessments and testing.
9. Inclement weather gear and/or clothing including a baseball cap for field training exercises and firing range.
10. Sam Brown belt and holster with all standard equipment. Body armor is mandatory for firearms training and qualification.
11. If you plan on rooming at the academy a \$5.00 key deposit is required and must be submitted during registration. You will need to bring personal items and toilet articles such as soap, shampoo, toothpaste, etc.

THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT ALLOWED:

"Clamshell," crossdraw, or shoulder holsters and chemical weapons such as "Mace" or "Cap-Stun"
