Who Should Attend

This training is being offered to Law Enforcement personnel that wish to teach the Basic Verbal Judo program. As Supervisors, would you like for your officers to have the skills to de-escalate a possible violent offender before the situation goes hands on? Have you ever been involved in a situation that could have been avoided if you just listened to the person instead of saying something you shouldn't have. Do you wish you had the right **TOOLS** to read a violent/non-violent subject as soon as you make contact with them.

This class will teach you active listening skills and how to teach others to use these skills. Further, it will help you to identify your weaknesses and overcome them. You will be able to do this for your officers also. You will learn what not to say during a conversation that will save you the hassle of a fight and will possibly save your life. If you really want your officers to be able to fully control a situation verbally this class will give you the skills to teach them.
